Biblical Foundation:


Focused Bible readings and short talks

foster joy and encouragement.



Overcoming Challenges Through Prayer

The path of ministry in Bangladesh is often met with hurdles, yet we view these as opportunities for God to demonstrate His provision.

- ⇒ **Technological Hurdles:** Many groups struggle with a lack of digital devices (tablets/phones), poor network connectivity, and insufficient sound equipment, which can hinder the quality of our Zoom gatherings.
- ⇒ **Socio-Economic Pressures:** Deep-seated poverty often forces members to choose between attending meetings and working in the fields or relocating for education and jobs.
- ⇒ **Spiritual Opposition:** In some regions, our groups face interference from local religious leaders or denominational opposition.

A Call to Stand with Us

As we look toward 2026, we humbly ask our supporters to join us in prayer for:

- ⌋ **Staff Safety:** For the physical and spiritual protection of our coordinators in sensitive areas.
- ⌋ **Stability:** That our groups would overcome device shortages and grow into mature, Christ-centered communities.
- ⌋ **Miraculous Provision:** That God would provide the essential resources—specifically digital devices, educational stipends, and travel funds—to bridge the gap between our calling and our capacity.

Nabagram School Extension: A collaborative blessing

We praise the Lord for the successful completion of the Nabagram Pre-primary Bible School Building Extension. For years, this school operated with minimal resources in a humble tin-roof building that was insufficient for the number of children wishing to enrol.

A Collaborative Blessing

Through a powerful partnership between **Life for Bangladesh** and **Barnabas AID**, we constructed a brand-new extension.

The project added two comfortable classrooms, full electrical systems (fans and lights), 20 sturdy bench sets, and essential learning tools like blackboards.

We rejoice in the academic and spiritual growth of our youth. Education is a key pillar of transformation, and this year, the Lord opened doors for our students to overcome financial barriers to their success.

Academic Support: We provided financial gifts to cover the Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) exam fees for **68 Life Group members**.

Overcoming Poverty: These students come from economically challenged backgrounds where such fees often represent an impossible hurdle to their future prospects.

A Growing Ministry: We are deeply encouraged to report that we assisted more students this year than last—a clear sign of God's increasing Favor on this mission.

Prayer Request: Please join us in praying for these 68 students. May the Lord grant them wisdom and strength as they sit for their exams, and may they see this support as a testimony of Christ's personal care for them.

Through divine providence,

we successfully placed the Holy Scriptures into the hands of those longing for Truth, our team made a concerted effort to visit each recipient's home, witnessing firsthand the profound joy and tears of gratitude as believers received their first complete Bible.

Project Impact: * 25 Bibles distributed, featuring durable leather zip covers for long-lasting use.

Reaching the Marginalized: Focus was placed on rural and tribal communities in regions like Rangpur and Dinajpur, where full access to the Bible was previously limited.

Supporting "Hidden" Believers: Discreet distribution was provided to those from different faith backgrounds who cannot openly acquire a Bible due to community sensitivity.

The Movement of God: #BeStrong

Life Group Pre-Christmas 2025: Light of Christmas


On December 19th, 2025, we celebrated our final Weekly Life Group meeting of the year with a spectacular online event.
